THE EVOLUTION OF USPA



2005

USPA is founded as a family business in May from a bedroom in NY, securing its first government contract in Oneida County. Jamie Evans is CEO.



2010

USPA guards an undercover reporter for an Oprah Network documentary, refocusing charity work on missing girls and trafficking.



2021

Daniel Manning becomes CEO; Brian Fitzgibbons is appointed VP, leading fire watch and continuing missing persons investigations.



1994

Founder, Michael Evans begins a law enforcement career as a park ranger, federal police officer & dispatcher; develops skills.



2007

Michael Evans leaves law enforcement, becomes CEO, fully commits to USPA, and lands a major Suffolk County contract to protect communities from sex offenders.



2011

USPA expands nationwide, launching franchises and rebranding its nonprofit unit as Kingsman to enhance charitable efforts.



2023

USPA recruits special operations veterans, advances green initiatives, and invests in R&D to lead industry innovations.
